

Svali on the truth about child trafficking

Incredible survivor Svali joins us to share some of her lived experiences within Illuminati / Jesuit cults where she was trained as a programmer and an oracle. This week we discuss the horrific practice of child trafficking that is a huge money spinner for the cults. Svali shares how Amsterdam, sin city, is the centrepiece of these operations. Interview starts

Gabbi Choong: Welcome everyone. Today we welcome back Svali. You may know Svali from her incredible book, *Breaking Free of Cult Programming*^{1 2}, and her blog *Svali Speaks*³. Svali was able to break free from the cult group where she was being used as a programmer, and an oracle. And through her own healing journey over many years, she has created some amazing resources, that detail the techniques, the rituals, and the procedures used during mind control programming. Her articles are so valuable, both for people beginning to learn about this evil, that's been hidden from sight for so long, as well as for survivors who are healing from ritual abuse and mind control. I'll add the link for Svali's website in the video notes.

We were actually discussing what would be a great topic to focus on, and Svali suggested child sex trafficking. And I feel this is such an important area to unpack. We know that the funds generated by the horrific practice of selling children, is such a huge dollar earner for the cults. And while recent movies suggest trafficking occurs in very far away places, and third world countries, the truth is this modern day slavery is happening all around us, in first world countries, in the US, in Europe, and right here in Australia as well.

Svali has a book about the Vatican, that is free and part of her blog on her website. And here she reveals how Amsterdam is actually the worldwide centre for infant and child sex trafficking. And while the city is known for its red light district, its relaxed stance on brothels, its sexual deviancy and its free flowing drugs, it's another whole level to see under those red lights. It's not even just under age women, which is bad enough, that are being sold on the streets, it is actually our very youngest, and our most vulnerable. So welcome Svali, and thank you for suggesting such an important topic. I actually, until I read your blog, I had no idea that Amsterdam was the centrepiece, or it was the sin city for paedophiles. So that was a real surprise to me. and I would love for you to share what that setup in Amsterdam looks like, and how it functions as a huge black market money spinner for these occultic networks?

2:24 **Svali:** Okay. Gabbi thank you. And thank you for having me again to talk about this topic. This is a very difficult topic to talk about in some ways. So if I hesitate, it's because I'm trying to calm myself down emotionally. I've a lot of feeling surrounding this one. But that's why I felt it was so important to share about it too.

GC: Take your time. Absolutely.

Svali: 2:50 And also, this is based on my memories when I was in the group, in the order. And I know that it's been at least 16 years since I've not had real contact. So things may have changed since then. So what I'm describing is based on my memories, how things were, at least up until maybe 2006, give or take. I don't think things probably have changed that much since then.

GC: [Some of Gabbi's comments and questions from now on are summarised.] Amsterdam is a real surprise to me. I was picturing maybe Ukraine, or even China, as a headquarters. How do they hide this operation in such a busy tourist area?

4:13 **Svali:** Amsterdam, at least for the order I was in, was the financial centre of the trafficking industry with infants and children. And one of the reasons is because it does have very liberal laws. And what I recall is that I did spend part of my childhood there, with someone that I called Uncle Lou and Aunt Mary. Those were pseudonyms actually. And what happens is, they were brokers in the industry. Because in the trafficking industry you have people known as brokers. And what they do is, they're responsible for producing and having transported infants and children, into different places. So what I recall is that this is the head area where a lot of brokers in the industry congregate, in Amsterdam. And even I remember going to coffee houses in Amsterdam, and there are certain ones that were not generally used much publicly. They were kind of private coffee houses, where the brokers would get together, and discuss the sheets, like the current prices for infants, children and things like that.

As a child, Uncle Lou said he wanted me to learn everything about the trade. And so what I had to do is, I had to go in a van with several people. And we actually went through parts of Eastern Europe, including Ukraine, and countries in that area. And we would do various trips. Other trips we would go to Asia.

And they would visit orphanages. And they were dressed very nicely, and had business suits. And they would talk to the heads of orphanages, and say that they could find good homes for the children. And then what they would do, is they would also give a huge donation to the orphanage. And then they would go through and select the children they wanted. And these were often overcrowded, understaffed orphanages, with very little funds. And so they would go place to place. They might take one or two children from one, two or three from another, until the van was full.

And what I recall, is that there were also a couple of older ladies, whose job was to take care of the infants in the back; it was a huge, like a transport cargo truck van. It was big. And what they would do, is they would take care of these infants, as we were transporting. They would give them bottles, change their diapers. And these were women who were sworn to secrecy, on pain of their entire families being wiped out, if they ever shared any information. So they were under strictest secrecy too. I remember helping to give some of the babies bottles, and changing them.

When we were going through areas that were considered sensitive, or where there could be a lot of checkpoints, sometimes they would give the babies something to mildly sedate them, so they wouldn't cry while we were going through them. But most of the checkpoints had already been bribed, and they were just waved through. And it wasn't just infants and children, though. Sometimes it was young teenage girls too.

And then, when we'd get back to the city, there was a warehouse where we would go to. And it would look like a company warehouse. And they would unload. There's an area with a lot of security, and it looks like it would be for a corporation with high security. So no-one would suspect that they were actually bringing human beings into their warehouse. And of course they had security guards everywhere as well, and they would just unload these infants and children.

And then what they would do is, while they were there, then the brokers would come. And the brokers would represent various brothels around Europe. And the brokers would come and then they would put bids in. And they start bidding on infants, and children and young teens. And when they put in their bids; I mean, because this is so hard to talk about. It's horrifying.

GC: Take your time.

Svali: 9:03 Oh my gosh, they treat them like a commodity! They have a checklist, and they say, 'I need three females. I need at least this many blondes. I need four boys. And I need ...' And by the way there are as many boys trafficked as girls. I don't know where people get the idea that it's women. There were just as many boys.

So one broker might say, 'I've an order for ten boys. I want three Caucasians, two Asians, this many with dark skin.' And they would name the nationalities or ethnicities they were looking for, or what their clients were looking for. And they would just select them from the children. Of course they had put in their orders ahead of time, so that's what the people in the van were looking for.

And then they would just take them. And they would take them to various brothels. Like one of the brokers bought for a chain of brothels that was located, say, in France, throughout France, and another for UK. So different brokers from different countries would come in, buy there, and then get the children.

And sometimes they would transport them from the last checkpoint, directly to a warehouse closer to the country of origin. But sometimes they would just come directly to the warehouse, and look over what they called the goods. I know it sounds so demeaning, but that's what they called them. They'd say, 'We want to look over the goods today.'

But the first selection went to the auction houses. There's special auction houses, such as outside of Paris, France. Outside of Paris, France, there's a very infamous auction house. And they'll take infants, and children, and young teens, as well as children that have been genetically bred too. Sometimes they'll bring in children that've been genetically bred, specifically with certain characteristics that I won't go into here.

And so, then what the very wealthy would do, is they'll sit there, and they'll have a dinner. Say the dinner will start at 6pm, and it will last a couple of hours, wine and dinner, and everyone's in their gowns, and their jewels, and their tuxedos. And it looks like a high class charity ball, for an extremely wealthy organisation. But it's not. It's horrendous. And so some of these children will go to an auction house like this. And they're in various countries too. France isn't the only one. It's just the one that I have some of the clearest memories of.

Because I had to go to dinner with a first class S.O.B., who insisted that I wear a Dior gown. This is while I was in my teens, and sit next to him, while he and his friends would sit, and then they would start the auctioning, maybe at around 11.30pm, midnight. And they'd start with the teens first. So the teen girls and boys would be up there, and they would start bidding. And these wealthy people are bidding on them for their private little parties that they have.

GC: It's just horrendous, picturing that lifestyle. For them it's this event where they get dressed up ...

Svali: 12:56 It's horrible! And then as the night went on, the children got younger, and younger, and younger. Until at about 4am, they're bidding on the infants. Because sometimes those kinds of people like babies too.

GC: It's just heartbreaking.

Svali: 13:56 It's horrible. This is a painful topic. But people need to know that this happens. So then they have their little private parties, and then they take these children, and they don't survive.

GC: Are there children hurt at the actual event, or is it more like a sale, and then people take the children?

Svali: 14:33 I'll share later about a different type of trafficking. But the ones that are bought at auction, what they do then is they'll have a little private party with these children, which are considered expendable because they've been purchased. And then what they do, is they snuff them. This is part of their pleasure. I don't mean to be horrible and graphic, but they derive great satisfaction, or whatever you call it, in doing things like that. And sometimes there is a ritual too. There'll be an infant

maybe at the ritual. But sometimes it's just for their own pleasure they do that. There's some really sick people out there.

GC: Can you talk about the difference between the treatment of generational children & those who are classed as expendable?

Svali: 16:03 I'm describing the expendables that are bought at auction. But one of my first memories myself of being trafficked, was when I was three years old. I had a twin sister. And what they would do is, they put jewelled leashes on my sister and I, and they brought us into the party. And these were all wealthy people in France, and sometimes in Germany, depending. They were in the Illuminati. You would know their names. But I'm not going to be a name dropper. Because to me, who cares. It was so perverted.

And sometimes at those kinds of parties, with the children that aren't expendable, we had a special temporary tattoo put on us, that said you can't kill this person. And they knew that their life would be in danger if they killed us. So they always stopped short of that. But they were allowed to do almost anything short of that. And so [at times? unclear] we were put up on a pedestal, and for fun they'd bid on who got to have the twins, or who got to have the set of triplets. And this is where you'd see your genetically enhanced children, who were bred specifically for these parties. Like a child with two genitalia, or three breasts, or things like that. And there are people that like crap like that.

GC: Such depravity.

Svali: 17:42 And then, of course, we'd been trained since we were little to perform certain acts, and to accept, and to do it. They knew too what our training was during the bidding. And they'd say, they can do this, this and this. It's like describing how a dog can jump, and bark, and jump through a hoop. Well they would describe the sexual activities that we could do, and perform.

And then whoever got you for the night, they used us. And sometimes you really thought you might not make it through the night. If someone was drunk and laying over you, and you're three years old, and you can barely breathe, that's kinda hard, you know. No matter whether you're wearing the tattoo or not. You're trying to crawl out from under them, so you can at least breathe. And you're looking out for your twin, hoping that she's OK too. But what they didn't know is that while we were at these parties, we were also gathering intelligence for the fathers too. They were using us as little spies. And of course the wealthy people at these parties never suspected that.

GC: No, not with such young children right?

Svali: 18:58 Yeah. And people talk in front of kids. And they'll share stuff that's going on, and their business, and their business deals, and their politics. If they're drunk enough they'll talk a lot. They think that kids are like a piece of wood, that they don't think. Which was used, I guess, to the Order's advantage. But it was an awful weight when you're three. All you're thinking about is I hope they see that tattoo on me.

GC: Of course, just the fear.

Svali: 19:30 Yeah. So it's another type of trafficking that goes on. And it goes on throughout childhood.

I will mention one person. In my teens, I was a mistress to Davide Rothschild, in France. He'd love the auction houses, and he knew I had friends who were brokers. So he used my [pauses]. I was what, thirteen, fourteen. He liked young teens, and young women. By the time I was twenty-one, I was too old to be of much interest to him. Except we were quote unquote friends by then, or so he thought. So we'd still get together for these dinners.

GC: So you're too old at twenty-one. What an inverted lifestyle. And how old would he have been at that time, may I ask?

Svali: 20:40 He was older than I was. He was quite a bit older than I was at that time. But that whole family is perverse. But anyway that's a side note. I don't mean to go, and rant about them.

So the brokers keep meticulous records too, of their buys and sells. And they call it the list. And it would come out weekly with the latest prices on children. And like I said they would supply the brothels, and the auction houses. And some of the very wealthy families, like the Rothschilds and the Battenbergs, would have their own private broker. And that's all you would do, is go to the warehouses and select children that he knew they would like. They call them the procurateur, or the procurers, for them. So they're the family purchasing agent who buys their children.

GC: That reminds me of a Jimmy Savile character, going around and scoping people out. You mentioned a list. That they had a set price. It's like a stock exchange.

Svali: 22:11 Yes, it's like the stock market. It's horrendous. The brokers have the list, and it's updated weekly. So the brokers know exactly what the going rate, for say a blond blue eyed Caucasian boy would be, or an Asian female of four years old who's been trained to do certain sexual acts, or a Malaysian set of twins that are two years old. So they actually have lists they use as the starting point for their pricing, of course updated based on what the going rate is. And it is a huge, huge, huge money maker. And that's the sadness of it all too. They make a lot of money. I mean millions, and millions, and millions, and millions and millions.

GC: And it's all black ops money. So there's no tax. It just disappears into these occult groups.

Svali: 23:22 Well, except there was one person that I know, that in Amsterdam, that the brokers had to pay a percentage of their fees to. And that's the father over Amsterdam.

GC: Wow. So a Jesuit father?

Svali: 23:39 Yes. And they paid him his tithe. And that's why I was raised by people who were brokers, so that I could go then and work for some of the brokerage houses, and see if they were being honest and paying their money. That was one of my jobs as a teen, was to help keep the books.

GC: What a huge business, if they're having to put people in to watch.

Svali: It is a horrendous, sordid, sordid, sordid business.

GC: To give people watching an idea. I know this is going back sixteen years ago now. But would you have any idea of how many children might be traded in a week, and what sort of prices they are talking about?

Svali: 24:39 Well a fair skinned infant at the going rate at that time, like a Caucasian looking infant, would go for close to a hundred thousand dollars. A pair of twins, let's say of Asian descent, who maybe were three years old, and were trained in certain sexual gymnastics, might go for a hundred and fifty to two hundred thousand, for the pair.

GC: Huge money

Svali: 25:13 Yeah, a lot of money, for some of them. For a teenage girl, of say thirteen or fourteen, going to the brothels, the prices would be lower. It might be fifty thousand, or forty thousand. It depended on how much use they felt they could get for her, how attractive she was, and other factors. Some of the teens, when they got there, they would have a special area where they were taken to, the girls and boys. And then they would sit there and get them addicted to drugs first, before they would take them to the brothels. Some of the brothels want them to be addicts, so that they could control them. And there's less chance that they would break away or try to run away. It's incredibly evil the things they do.

GC: It's difficult for people in general to comprehend the scope of this.

Svali: 26:49 And they also come into America. One route was from Quebec. They would come down through Canada, through Toronto, and then down into New York City. So it's very common in the US too.

I did see the movie, Sound of Freedom. I don't know if you've heard of it?

GC: I haven't seen it myself. But others have told me it's a very sheltered look at the industry, considering who it was made by.

Svali: 27:29 Yes, exactly. But it did show just one tiny slice. Except it didn't show the extent of it. It didn't show the very, very, very young children. And it implied that they were coming from Mexico, and South America, and through the cartels. And that's only one slice of the pie. That's a very small section of the trafficking.

One way they get gals into Canada, was that they would put ads, like nanny wanted, or housekeeper, or model wanted. And they would get these teenage girls to apply. Or, come learn English, and be paid at the same time. And then they would just disappear. And they would go to the brothels.

New York was a large centre, Phoenix, Arizona. Los Angeles is another. They actually have trafficking routes, where vans full of these girls, and children are just transported across the US. It's bad, it's really bad. And it's much more extensive than that movie showed, I'll tell you that. But the reason I'm talking about this at all; it's horrendous to hear about; is people need to become aware of the extent of this. There's a lot of evil going on in this area. And young children who are just being exploited horrifically.

GC: Absolutely. It's so important.

Svali: 29:05 And it's been covered up. No-one's reporting on it. No-one's investigating it. I went to a trafficking conference here in the US, of several years ago. And there's a F.B.I. agent talking about the sting operations they were doing. And I'm listening, and I'm thinking, they're getting one or two pimps off of the street corner. And so I went to him later, and I said, "What about the large scale international trafficking that's been done through these ports of entry", and I mentioned a few, "Are you doing anything about that?" And he just looked at me like, uh no, like I had a horn in the middle of my forehead or something. He just said, uh no, no, no. He acted really nervous and he left. He went to the other side of the room. And I thought, well that answers that, why we're not hearing more about the real problem, why we're hearing the sanitised version in the media, that just tells us little tiny bits, here and there.

GC: So true. It's always portrayed as one house, a small group of men. Never the large network.

Svali: 30:18 And that is a real issue. I'm not at all downplaying the woman who's been trafficked out of financial need, or because her boyfriend got her into it, or because her gang is doing it. I am not at all dismissing the painful aspects of that, or how horrific that is too. But I'm saying that's not the whole picture. And usually when you hear about trafficking, that's all you hear about.

GC: That's right. We're not given the big picture that you're describing now, which is international, both targeting and then feeding children through to these destinations all over the world. It's so coordinated, to have whole trucks. How many young women, and children, and babies would be on a truck like the one that you experienced?

Svali: 31:11 Oh gee. There might be three dozen infants on a trip. And then there might be twenty older children. Because they had little sleeping mats, and you know like in the army, how they have those little fold out cots that are in rows, on the sides. Well they had these little beds that would come down in rows, almost like in a navy ship. So they'd have the older children sleeping in those. On a trip like that you'd probably have about six older caretakers helping too. Helping to feed the children, keep them quiet, take care of the infants, sedate the children and infants if you're going through a checkpoint where you wanted them to be silent, in case there were people nearby, besides the guards. Although they tend to go through in the middle of the night when no-one else is around. It's all very well organised and plotted out. But you can get a lot of kids in the back of one of those, just laying down in their little cot, their little beds

GC: That's actually so much more than I was expecting you to even say Svali. That's just huge. And obviously like you were saying, these checkpoints must have a deal and be paid off. Because that truck, if anybody looked in it, there's no excuse for having that amount of children.

Svali: 33:00 Yes. Well it looks like a business truck on the outside of course. It looks very legitimate. But yes, they pay a lot of money, or even try to have some of their people get jobs at the checkpoints too, and if there's someone who is sympathetic to them, or who is mind controlled, or who's been paid off to wave them through; they really organise it well.

GC: Just think, the way they would be looking at that truck's cargo. The amount of money they would be able to sell those innocent children and young people for. They've got plenty of money to grease that truck's way through. It's horrific.

Svali: 33:43 And if you realise though; they call them cargoes, are coming in weekly. They use different routes. They don't use the same routes all the time. And they don't go the same places. They have places all over the world they go to to get children

from. And I'm talking about Europe, but they do it in other countries of course; India, Malaysia, China, Russia, and South America too.

GC: I was going to ask you Svali. Because we know with the Jesuits being the military arm of the Vatican, and obviously so many children become vulnerable and targeted when the U.S. goes into a country and starts a war. Like in Afghanistan, or Iraq, there were so many children that went into trafficking networks, went into organ harvesting and that sort of thing. Did you ever see those kind of children coming into Europe, or potentially were they sold somewhere closer I guess as well?

Svali: 34:51 Not so much that way. Let's say a fictional country in Africa is at civil war. Sometimes what these people will do is they will swoop in, with permission. They will come into a village and pay off whatever regime is in charge, a huge amount of money to allow them to come in and scoop children out of the village.

It's unbelievable, but there are some countries who have that kind of corruption. But these are the same kind of countries that take children as child soldiers into their own army. But there's unbelievable corruption where they say, there's this village of a tribe that's at war with the main government, and they say, "Can we go into that village and just take their kids and infants?" And they'll say, "Oh yeah. Get rid of them." And then they say, we'll pay you millions to let us do this, and they do.

GC: It's horrific. There never seems to be a shortage for these people that are searching for vulnerable children and infants. They've got so many places to look, right?

Svali: 36:02 And then sometimes, to cover it, they'll say that the army came in and committed genocide, and destroyed the village. Well, not the whole village.

GC: Yes. What about the children? What about the infants?

Svali: 36:18 Maybe the adults, but not the children. I wish I didn't know about things like this, Gabbi, I really do.

GC: It must be so hard to go back into these memories again. So thank you for your time, and sharing it with us. Because I feel it's so important that we give people a clearer picture of what child trafficking is about. Not the very limited picture that they're being given; at least people are now aware of it because of publications and movies that are going out. But I think this is a great interview to share with someone that's maybe seen that movie, to give them an actual idea of the extent of it. Because until we really understand how big these networks are, and how they are operating, really unhindered above our governments. Until we realise that, how do we stop it?

You mentioned about the Jesuit priest overseeing the Amsterdam area. Just in terms of the structure, I would love to ask, were there other occultic groups working under the Jesuits there? Are the brokers from different occultic groups for example that were starting to traffic children from the network as well?

Svali: 37:38 Oh yes. Some of the brokers were somewhat independent brokers. Some were working for groups. And then, like I said, you had the procurateurs who worked for the private wealthy families. So you would see a mix of that. So you might see various groups. Definitely you'd see various groups coming in, or their brokers coming in and bidding. For the private parties of the wealthy, it tended to be the procurateurs would come and get children. And they were always given first choice. And then after that the brokers for the large brothels, or for the large sex clubs. My memories are, all over Europe there's private sex clubs where anything goes, including paedophilia and all kind of nasty things.

GC: Did you say all over Europe, Svali?

Svali: 38:34 Well, what I mean is in various countries over Europe. I don't mean all over everywhere.

There's private sex clubs where anything goes, anything. I'm talking about things like being allowed to go and take a child and put its head in a toilet and flush it. Because that's what some people like to do.

GC: It's just sickening.

Svali: 39:07 Yes, things like that. And animal shows with children. And they have them in the US too, and in Mexico, South America, Russia, China. Lots of countries have them, and these are very private exclusive underground sex clubs. So the brokers also supply children for those too.

GC: I remember reading in your blog, which I found quite interesting, and shocking, how in Amsterdam, because these clubs, where children are offered for sale, for this horrific depravity of sexual activities. That people need to find these places, so they have special ways of letting people know what's on offer. And you mentioned in your blog how in Amsterdam in the red light district they would have a woman who was for sale, actually cradling an infant very late at night. There's so many tourists that would walk past and think maybe she's babysitting or ... You wouldn't think, oh my God they're selling children. But it's so clear looking at it now.

Svali: 40:40 I don't know if they still do that. That was back then. Probably since I've done my blog, they've stopped

GC: It might be too obvious now, who knows.

Svali: 40:50 But back then they would do that. And the children were the prostitutes that ran the streets. It was awful. That was awful too.

GC: So far from home. And they would've been vulnerable children already, that have probably had such hard days. Which is one thing, but to end up within occultic groups practising horrific rituals and sexual depravity. That's just beyond belief isn't it?

Svali: 41:29 So I think I've lifted the lid off of a very ugly, ugly, ugly international problem. What I do wish, is that something could be done. I wish there was a way that these auction houses could be stopped. That the buying and selling could be stopped. I wish there was a way that something could be done.

GC: I was actually going to ask you Svali, as well, from someone that has seen such huge operations. What do you see as the solution going forwards? Because we've all been banging our heads against the wall over this.

Svali: 42:50 Well I don't know about a solution, but I'm going to mention my Christian faith here, but prayer; I believe we need to pray against the demonic, that feeds this kind of a system. I believe that as a Christian that we need to pray for those trapped in it, that they get free. Including the brokers, because so many people in the industry, from the bottom up, are just trapped. That the poor women who are trapped, who are blackmailed into taking care of the children would get free. It's going to take a miracle, and we need to pray that God would do that miracle, and bring change into some of the human hearts.

I think helping to increase awareness that this is an issue. Because right now a lot of people are reeling from the thought that, 'Oh my gosh. You mean children get trafficked?', at all. Even eight year olds, they have trouble believing that. But we live in a world where, denial, people look the other way. They don't want to believe these things happen. Maybe educating people. Maybe some of the survivors who are now speaking out. I think that we can pray, that this not only gets exposed, but that people in the media would be willing to report it. That people in the legal system, or the justice systems, would be willing to do something about it. That we come against any demonic protection over what's happening. That we pray against that demonic, and just ask that God take it down, and expose this, and help people to get free, that He would set the captives free.

GC: I love that. I think it's so important to realise that behind a very physical problem of children being targetted, and then handled, and trafficked all over the world for these horrific practices, there is that spiritual component of these dark entities and demonics, that are encouraging and basically behind these people's actions. So it's a beautiful way to look at it Svali, the power that we can together as a community, to

pray over these networks to be exposed, to be shut down. For the children to be able to come out.

Survivors bravely speaking out, like yourself Svali, as well. I know today would've been really difficult, talking about the abuse of young children. Those courageous stories are really highlighting this evil, the truth of this evil that we need to know. We need to have the entire picture of it, not just a G rated version of trafficking, for us to be able to solve the problem. So thank you so much for so bravely covering such a traumatic area. I hope for people watching, that you can take action through you taking some time to pray over this, making that a regular part of your day. Because for these children it is their day, and it is their lives. So that's something really beautiful that we can do, is to try and pray over this entire situation to be exposed and shut down.

And pass on this interview to people that have some awareness of trafficking, or maybe have seen a movie recently about it, but don't really understand the full depths of it. This is a great time to actually give them some more information. Because they know that trafficking exists, at least. Just that they don't really have the full picture. So thank you so much Svali. Is there anything else that you would like to finish on?

Svali: 46:56 Not really. At this point I think we covered quite a bit. But I do believe prayer does work. And I also believe in putting personal action. So if anyone feels led to write their congressmen and ask, 'Why isn't something being done about this?', or whoever, anyone who might have connections, or be aware of trafficking, just be aware that trafficking has a lot of layers to it. And maybe it's time to start doing something about the youngest and most vulnerable; the infants, the babies, and the young children.

GC: It's so true. Without us they don't have a voice. And by us all understanding the levels of trafficking, at least we're equipped to start being able to see this in our communities as well. And I always say to people that are learning about this, because it's such a dark topic, you can be proactive, both through prayer, and through educating others.

But keep an eye out. Constantly have your eyes open in the community. A couple of groups I know that are aware of trafficking; a few months ago they were at a pool, and they noticed a little girl getting targetted by an older man, trying to lure her into the toilet. So they were able to jump in and do something about it. And we don't know where that would have went. But because they're aware of trafficking, and they're aware of how these people work, they saw it.

So never think that something as simple as sharing an interview like this, or talking to someone about trafficking; it might help a child. It might save one from being

abused, and get them out of that horror much earlier. So we can all take action in our communities as well.

So thank you so much for your time Svali. It's always such a pleasure having you join us. And thank you for shining your light on such a horrific area that is so prolific in our world. And it's time for us to really push back on that darkness, and pray through it, so our children can be free. Thank you so much.
